# Cancer in North Carolina: Data and Resource Guide

Accurate cancer surveillance data is critical for local health boards, providers, and cancer partners in identifying populations in their communities at higher risk for developing cancer. The Cancer in North Carolina: Data and Resource Guide provides data on the status of the six priority cancers included in the North Carolina Comprehensive Cancer Control ACTION Plan 2020–2025. This report also contains data about where cancer risk factors are concentrated the highest, evidence-based intervention strategies, and resources. It was developed by NC Division of Public Health, Comprehensive Cancer Control Program in collaboration with the NC Breast and Cervical Cancer Control Program; NC WISEWOMAN Project; the NC State Center for Health Statistics, Central Cancer Registry and the North Carolina Advisory Committee on Cancer Coordination and Control.
